# HOW TO USE THIS DOT PLAY PACK

These dot play pages are designed for open-ended, screen-free learning. Children can use colors, materials, and tools of their choice to fill the circles. Use the ideas below to repeat the same pages in different ways.

## **Color & Paint**

- Color all dots using crayons or sketch pens
- Use one color or multiple colors
- Try finger painting for sensory play
- Dab paint using earbuds / Q-tips

## **Hands-On Play**

- Roll small playdough or clay balls and place on the dots
- Stick pom-poms using glue
- Paste circle stickers or bindis on each dot

## **Fine Motor Activities**

- Tear paper, roll small balls, and paste on dots
- Use tweezers to place pom-poms or paper balls
- Trace patterns (lines, dots, zigzags) inside the circles
- 

## **Early Learning Ideas**

- Count the dots before filling
- Roll a dice and color that many circles
- Fill big circles with big balls and small circles with small balls
- Create simple color patterns (red-blue-red)
- 

## **Open-Ended Play**

Let children explore, create, and repeat activities using different materials.

**Age Recommendation:** 3–6 years

**Skills Developed:** Fine motor skills, hand strength, focus, creativity, early math
